Good Morning,

You are undoubtedly still working to recover from the recent storms and outages, and I hope that is going as well as possible for you. I wanted to take a moment to share that even though City Hall is technically "closed" for the holidays, your City is doing the same thing.

Here's what's happening as of today:

- There is a full complement of Public Works staff in town today driving the street sweeper, clearing drains and gutters, attending to facility needs, performing additional tree cleanup and much more.
- We also called in our contract team to assist with the vegetation and debris cleanup.

If you see our team out there in the field, please be sure to say hello!

As our crews clean, we are also tracking a small storm that looks to arrive on Wednesday this week and hang around for a few days. Right now, the expected rainfall is around 1/2 inch per day or less, and there should be minimal wind. We will continue to monitor the system as it moves in and be ready to respond as needed.
