Hello everyone.

I've very recently spoken to our PG&E liaison, and she has told me that 900 houses now have power. I know for sure that one does - I'm not going to name any names, Chris - and the outage map confirms that these homes are in the northeast section of the city.

She has also confirmed that PG&E is where they anticipated (last night) that they'd be by this time tonight, that they are standing by their 11pm commitment, and that they are still very very optimistic that 90% of us will be lit before midnight. The exceptions should be localized to still unmanaged downed trees, of which there should be few. And as I write this, I see that another northwest section of town has had power restored.

**In the meantime, again tonight, the Youth Center will be open until 10pm with heat, lights, and power. And once again, The Carmel Foundation will be open to the community at 9am tomorrow morning for charging, lights, warm coffee, board games, etc.**

As before, please don't hesitate to call the police department non-emergency number at (831) 624-6403, or of course 911 if need be.

Stay safe, and as comfortable as you are able. Let's all collectively keep our fingers crossed for good things this evening.
