Dale's History associated with this honor – a partial background

- 1. Dale and his wife Margaret, after vacationing here routinely, and retiring from the sale of his technology firm, moved to our Village over 7 years ago and began engaging with civic teams as they invested in **rebuilding 4 homes in town**. His passion for improving and enhancing everything about living in Carmelby-the-Sea kicked in during these initial years.
- 2. He began volunteering weekly with the **Visitors Center** led by the Carmel Chamber of Commerce.
- 3. Dale also partnered with Lynn Momboisse to expand the Carmel-by-the-Sea **Voice Map Tours**, with surrounding nature and town offerings associated with *Adventures of a Home Town Tourist*. They cover much of our town, historical events, interesting characters, architecture, businesses; all emphasizing the importance of protecting our Village heritage.
- 4. He also joined **Carmel Residents Association** and became a board member for a year, where he applied his passions and past-life technical expertise by driving the rollout of new automation for membership and website etc. Plus, he crafted a program for businesses to extend CRA members special offers engaging residents with our businesses. Dale & Margaret remain motivated lifetime CRA members.
- 5. Then comes COVID19 in the winter 2020. As we all shut down per directives, in comes Dales' ideas for making a difference stream in. At this time, Dale partnered with Tim Allen, local realtor, to collaborate and charitably fund making a difference in these unique pandemic times in comes www.carmelgives.org. Just some of these resulting efforts included working with local seamstresses to make and then distribute free masks. He also engaged many Village restaurants to make meals and see they are delivered to those in need, plus they funded meal coupons from these restaurants to be redeemed by recipients at their leisure. This last effort kept many restaurants with their lights on, who struggled with the take-out only business.

Now comes the **formation of Carmel Cares** <u>www.carmelcares.org</u> As you visit this website you will see, "Carmel Cares is a 501(c)3 nonprofit volunteer organization dedicated to keeping Carmel-by-the-Sea a beautiful, safe, and inviting place through volunteer maintenance and improvement projects, branded community engagement programs, educational outreach, and other creative activities. We partner closely with the City of Carmel's Public Works Department and other nonprofit organizations to make a difference in our community."
